

STATEMENT ON SOS-UK OPERATIONS IN RELATION TO COVID-19

5 January 2021

Further to our earlier statements on 13, 17 and 24 March, and 22 September 2020, we have updated working practices in line with updated government advice announced on 4 January 2021.

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, we are taking steps to ensure we do not inadvertently spread the virus through our activities.

As such we are continuing the below actions until at least Easter 2021:

- All staff are continuing to work from home
- All staff are individually adhering to Government guidance on hygiene and self-isolation
- Our training, workshops, and meetings are being delivered remotely, using Skype for Business and Zoom
- We are working with our partners to deliver alternative support in lieu of planned in-person activities
- Planned regional and national events are being delivered either through online means or postponed to next academic year, in consultation with those attending.
